Q. Why take a PSAT/SAT Preparation class?

Unlike in years past, today most serious students preparing for their college education are taking a preparatory class to increase their college entrance exam scores. These students will have an advantage over those who do not take one.

TUITION BALANCE: If not paying in full by May 1st, the <u>balance amount of \$300.00 or \$650 is due at the first August class</u>. Please understand that providing low priced, small, effective classes does not allow for refunds for missed classes, whether planned or unplanned, however, missed classes can be made up during that week at any of the other locations.

GENERAL INFORMATION: The Prep Course addresses all three sections of the New SAT/New PSAT. Math is now 1/2 of the test; the Writing/Language and Reading sections together equal only 1/2 of the test. The Writing/Language preparation includes review of punctuation, grammar, sentence structure, and common usage errors. The Reading preparation includes an intense vocabulary study (including Latin and Greek prefixes, suffixes, and roots), as well as a study of successful test taking strategies. The Math preparation reviews geometry, the more extensive algebra covered on the SAT, and data analysis. Also taught, are time saving shortcuts and helpful strategies, such as back solving and using special numbers. Prep also includes interpreting relationships presented in graphs and tables, which is necessary for success in all three sections of the tests. General test-taking strategies are also taught. Weekly assignments include readings, vocabulary memorization, reworking math problems, and mastery of class notes. SAT/PSAT Practice Tests taken at home are an integral part of this course, providing the student an opportunity to practice newly learned skills. The Orientation Class, Writing Class, and summer vocabulary/grammar memorization schedule are designed to help students accomplish as much work as possible before the busy fall semester begins. The 8-week Preparation Course, is designed with the most effective timing in mind for PSAT and SAT. Classes begin the week of Monday, Aug. 2nd and finish Saturday. September 25th.
