THINGS TO REMEMBER

1. Spirit week should be fun and exciting but not at the expense of the students academic training. All activities must take place before and after school or during the lunchtime or break time.
2. **All planning and preparation work times that are held on campus must be with the supervision of the class sponsor or an approved sponsor.**
3. Faculty and students must abide by the TCS dress code at all school sponsored activities.
4. Boys may not dress as girls and girls dress as boys. Exceptions will be allowed if approved by a Principal. Students may not dress as inappropriate characters: pimps, gangsters, etc.
5. Students violating dress rules will have points deducted from their class.
6. No confetti at the pep rally or games.
7. **On competition days, classes will receive points based on percentage of sponsor participation up to 100 points. (ie. ½ sponsor participation will be 50 point etc.)**
8. Thursday lunch will be sold by the sophomore class. Junior high students will participate in the lunch.
9. Shorts must be no more than 3 inches above the knee. TCS spandex must be worn under all P.E. or athletic shorts. Capri's are allowed. Dresses or skirts must not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee and TCS spandex must be worn under them.
