

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS & PRIVACY ACT (FERPA) Rights of Access

The Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act specifies that school records are the property of the family. As a private school, we are exempt from this requirement, but choose to meet all confidentiality requirements provided to families through FERPA.

Therefore, we require families to authorize Temple Christian School (TCS) to share student records, which include, but are not limited to report cards, transcripts, test scores, and letters of recommendation. In addition, we require students to waive their right to view and/or access letters of recommendation written on their behalf.

Colleges or universities prefer teacher evaluations and recommendations to be confidential. Colleges generally believe that recommendations written with this understanding are more candid and honest. Therefore those recommendations have more validity and carry appreciably more weight in the admissions process that recommendations where parents and students have access.
