## **Semester Exam Exemption Policy**

Exemption from semester testing is a privilege, not a right. **English, math, science, and Bible** are core courses at TCS, and students are not allowed to be exempt from these classes.

## To be considered exempt, all the following criteria must be met:

- 1. The semester grade must be (average of 3rd and 4th 9-week grades)
  - 85 or higher average in all on-level classes.
  - 90 or higher average in all honors classes, receiving the extra honors grade points (+7).
- 2. Students may not receive:
  - More than 5 Homework Remediation assignments considering all classes together during the semester.
  - More than 3 fines during the semester.
  - Checked out more than 5 temporary student IDs in a semester.
  - More than 5 unexcused tardies to any one class during the semester. More than 5 to any class disqualifies a student from exemptions for all classes.
  - May not have more than five absences per class during the semester, or the test for that class must be taken.
  - ISS or OSS during the semester.

If it is deemed necessary, the administration may exclude any student from test exemption due to disciplinary action.
